How does Campbell & Fetter Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Campbell & Fetter Bank collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing? Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Campbell & Fetter Bank does not share with our affiliates.</i> 	
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Campbell & Fetter Bank does not share with nonaffiliates.</i> 	
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include financial product companies.

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For California Customers. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.
